

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 2575, WITH
INSTRUCTIONS
OFFERED BY M____. _____**

M____. _____ moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 2575, to the Committee on Ways and Means with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill add the following:

1 SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by section
3 2 shall not take effect if it results in any of the following:

4 (1) PROHIBITION ON LOSS OF WORK HOURS OR
5 WAGES.—A reduction in hours worked, and subse-
6 quent loss of wages, in order to skirt requirements
7 to help pay for employee health care costs.

8 (2) ENSURING FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AND A
9 LOWER DEFICIT.—Any increase in the Federal def-
10 icit.

11 (b) PROTECTING HEALTH INSURANCE FOR VET-
12 ERANS AND WOUNDED WARRIORS.—The amendments
13 made by section 2 shall not apply to veterans or their fam-
14 ilies.

1 (c) BEING A WOMAN MUST NOT BE A PRE-EXISTING
2 CONDITION.—Nothing in this Act shall be construed to
3 authorize an employer to—

4 (1) eliminate, weaken, or reduce health cov-
5 erage benefits for current employees;

6 (2) increase premiums or out-of-pocket costs;

7 (3) deny coverage based on pre-existing condi-
8 tions; or

9 (4) discriminate against women in health insur-
10 ance coverage, including by—

11 (A) charging women more for their health
12 care than men;

13 (B) limiting coverage for pregnancy and
14 post-natal care; or

15 (C) restricting coverage of preventive
16 health services, such as mammograms and con-
17 traception.
