

## MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

\_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2804 to the Committee on the Judiciary with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

Add, at the end of the bill, the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1           **TITLE V—MISCELLANEOUS**  
2                                   **PROVISION**

3   **SEC. 501. NO DELAY OF ANY REGULATION THAT SAVES TAX**  
4                                   **DOLLARS, HELPS SMALL BUSINESSES AND**  
5                                   **VETERANS, PREVENTS DISCRIMINATION, OR**  
6                                   **PROTECTS CONSUMERS.**

7           This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall  
8 not apply in the case of any rule, consent decree, or settle-  
9 ment agreement that—

10                   (1) saves tax dollars or provides refunds, re-  
11 bates, or savings for taxpayers;

12                   (2) provides assistance and regulatory relief for  
13 small businesses;

14                   (3) expedites or settles cases involving veterans  
15 benefits;

1           (4) prevents discrimination based on race, reli-  
2           gion, national origin, or any other protected cat-  
3           egory, or that provides pay equity for women; or

4           (5) protects the health and safety of consumers,  
5           seniors, and children, including ensuring—

6                   (A) the safety of the food supply from sal-  
7                   monella and other food-borne illnesses; or

8                   (B) a safe drinking water supply that is  
9                   free from toxic substances and chemicals that  
10                  can cause cancer.
