

MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

_____ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 4138 to the Committee on the Judiciary with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 SEC. 3. PROTECTING STATES' RIGHTS.

2 Nothing in this Act limits or otherwise affects any
3 action taken by the President, the head of a department
4 or agency of the United States, or any other officer or
5 employee of the United States, in order to prevent an un-
6 constitutional intrusion into States' rights.

**7 SEC. 4. RESTORING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS FOR AMER-
8 ICA'S JOB SEEKERS.**

9 This Act shall not take effect until the most recent
10 percentage of the insured unemployed (those for whom un-
11 employment taxes were paid during prior employment)
12 who are receiving Federal or State unemployment insur-
13 ance (UI) benefits when they are actively seeking work
14 is at least equal to the percentage receiving such benefits
15 for the last quarter of 2013, as determined by the Depart-
16 ment of Labor's quarterly UI data summary measurement

1 of the Unemployment Insurance reciprocity rate for all UI
2 programs.
