

## MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

\_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 3590 to the Committee on Natural Resources with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

Page 3, after line 24, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 103. PROTECTING WATER SUPPLY FOR PUBLIC**  
2 **RECREATION AND SAFE DRINKING.**

3 Section 4 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (15  
4 U.S.C. 2603) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
5 lowing:

6 “(h) PROTECTING WATER SUPPLY FOR PUBLIC  
7 RECREATION AND SAFE DRINKING.—Not later than one  
8 year after the enactment of this subsection, any manufac-  
9 turer or processor of a chemical or mixture that has the  
10 potential to contaminate water supplies used for public  
11 recreation or drinking water provided by a public water  
12 system shall generate and provide to regulatory agencies  
13 data sufficient to understand the risks such chemical or  
14 mixture would present to human health and the environ-  
15 ment as appropriate, including studies of the chemical or  
16 mixture’s cancer-causing effects, reproductive toxicity and

1 neurotoxicity. Exposing the public or the environment to  
2 such chemical or mixture without generating such studies  
3 shall be considered a prohibited act under this Act.”.

At the end of the bill, add the following:

4 **SEC. 805. JOBS TO REBUILD AMERICA.**

5 Subject to appropriations, the text of H.R. 2428, as  
6 introduced on June 19, 2013, (the “SAFE Bridges Act”),  
7 is hereby enacted into law.
