

MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 2

_____ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2 to the Committee on Natural Resources and the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add at the end the following:

1 **DIVISION D—MISCELLANEOUS**
2 **PROVISIONS**

3 **SEC. 1. POLICING EXCESSIVE SPECULATION IN ENERGY**
4 **MARKETS.**

5 The Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) is
6 amended by redesignating section 44 as section 45, and
7 by inserting after section 43 the following:

8 **“SEC. 44. REVENUES TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE COM-**
9 **MODIFY FUTURES TRADING COMMISSION.**

10 “(a) ESTABLISHMENT OF TREASURY ACCOUNT.—
11 The Secretary of the Treasury (in this section referred to
12 as the ‘Secretary’) shall establish an account in the Treas-
13 ury of the United States.

14 “(b) DEPOSIT INTO ACCOUNT OF CERTAIN REVE-
15 NUES GENERATED BY THIS ACT.—The Secretary shall

1 deposit into the account established under subsection (a)
2 \$10,000,000 of the total of the amounts received by the
3 United States each fiscal year under leases issued under
4 this Act or any plan, strategy, or program under this Act.

5 “(c) AVAILABILITY AND USE OF FUNDS.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
7 the amounts in the account established under sub-
8 section (a) shall be made available to the Commodity
9 Futures Trading Commission to use its existing au-
10 thorities to limit excessive speculation in energy
11 markets.

12 “(2) SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATIONS.—The au-
13 thority provided in paragraph (1) may be exercised
14 only to such extent, and with respect to such
15 amounts, as are provided in advance in appropria-
16 tions Acts.”.

17 **SEC. 2. PROTECTING NATIONAL SECURITY.**

18 Any lease issued pursuant to this Act shall specify
19 that United States oil, petroleum products, and natural
20 gas shall not be exported to any nation, corporation, or
21 person that—

22 (1) provides material support to al Qaeda, the
23 Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant, or other ter-
24 rorist organizations;

25 (2) is a state sponsor of terrorism; or

1 (3) steals America’s military technology or in-
2 tellectual property through cyber-attacks such as
3 Russia and China.

4 **SEC. 3. NO EXPEDITED PERMITTING FOR CORPORATIONS**
5 **THAT RELEASE TOXIC AIR POLLUTANTS**
6 **FROM PETROLEUM COKE.**

7 Section 17(p)(2) of the Mineral Leasing Act (30
8 U.S.C. 226(p)(2)), as amended by section 21111 of divi-
9 sion B of this Act, is further amended by adding at the
10 end the following:

11 “(F) NO EXPEDITED PERMITTING FOR
12 CORPORATIONS THAT RELEASE TOXIC AIR POL-
13 LUTANTS FROM PETROLEUM COKE.—Subpara-
14 graphs (A), (B), (C), and (D) shall not apply
15 to any corporation or other person that owns
16 petroleum coke stored at a petroleum coke facil-
17 ity, or owns or operates such a facility, that—

18 “(i) releases toxic air pollutants that
19 harm air quality or contaminate drinking
20 water; and

21 “(ii) is located within 5 miles of a
22 school, hospital, or nursing home.”.
