

## MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

### Ensuring pay increase and continued payments to military personnel for fiscal year 2016

\_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 1735 to the Committee on Armed Services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

At the end of subtitle A of title VI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6 \_\_\_\_ . GUARANTEEING A PAY INCREASE FOR MEM-**  
2 **BERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES AND NO**  
3 **LAPSE IN PAY CAUSED BY A GOVERNMENT**  
4 **SHUTDOWN.**

5 (a) INCREASE IN BASIC PAY.—As provided in section  
6 1009 of title 37, United States Code, and effective on Jan-  
7 uary 1, 2016, the increase for fiscal year 2016 in the rates  
8 of monthly basic pay authorized for members of the uni-  
9 formed services shall be 2.3 percent.

10 (b) RESPONSE TO LAPSE IN APPROPRIATIONS.—The  
11 Secretary of Defense shall take all steps necessary to en-  
12 sure that members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Ma-  
13 rine Corps continue to receive compensation for their serv-

1 ice in defense of the United States despite any lapse in  
2 appropriations after September 30, 2015.
