

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 10**

**OFFERED BY M**\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_

M\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 10 to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add at the end of section 6 the following new subsection:

1           (f) REQUIRING PROTECTION OF STUDENTS AND AP-  
2 PLICANTS UNDER CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS.—Section 3008  
3 (sec. 38-1853.08, D.C. Official Code) is amended by add-  
4 ing at the end the following new subsection:

5           “(i) REQUIRING PROTECTION OF STUDENTS AND AP-  
6 PLICANTS UNDER CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS.—In addition to  
7 meeting the requirements of subsection (a), an eligible en-  
8 tity or a school may not participate in the opportunity  
9 scholarship program under this Act unless the eligible en-  
10 tity or school certifies to the Secretary that the eligible  
11 entity or school will provide each student who applies for  
12 or receives an opportunity scholarship under this Act with  
13 all of the applicable protections available under each of  
14 the following laws:

1           “(1) Title IV of the Civil Rights Act of 1964  
2           (42 U.S.C. 2000c et seq.).

3           “(2) Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964  
4           (42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq.).

5           “(3) Title IX of the Education Amendments  
6           Act of 1972 (20 U.S.C. 1681 et seq.).

7           “(4) The Equal Educational Opportunities Act  
8           of 1974 (20 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.).

9           “(5) The Individuals With Disabilities Edu-  
10          cation Act (20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.).

11          “(6) The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C.  
12          701 et seq.).

13          “(7) The Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (42  
14          U.S.C. 6101 et seq.).

15          “(8) The Americans with Disabilities Act of  
16          1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.).”.
