

MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

_____ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2406 to the Committee on Natural Resources with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **TITLE** **XVII—PROTECTING**
2 **WATER SUPPLY FOR PUBLIC**
3 **RECREATION AND SAFE**
4 **DRINKING**

5 **SEC. 1701. FINDINGS.**

6 Congress finds as follows:

7 (1) Every year in the United States, an esti-
8 mated 4,000 tons of lead are lost in ponds and
9 streams as fishing tackle, such as fishing lures and
10 sinkers.

11 (2) The lead content of fishing tackle has the
12 potential to contaminate water supplies.

1 **SEC. 1702. PROTECTING WATER SUPPLY FOR PUBLIC**
2 **RECREATION AND SAFE DRINKING.**

3 Section 4 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (15
4 U.S.C. 2603) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(h) PROTECTING WATER SUPPLY FOR PUBLIC
7 RECREATION AND SAFE DRINKING.—Not later than one
8 year after the date of enactment of this subsection, any
9 manufacturer or processor of an article containing a chem-
10 ical substance or mixture that has the potential to con-
11 taminates water supplies used for public recreation or
12 drinking water provided by a public water system shall
13 generate and provide to all applicable Federal and State
14 agencies responsible for protecting health or the environ-
15 ment data sufficient to understand the risks such article
16 would present to human health and the environment, in-
17 cluding studies of the cancer-causing effects, reproductive
18 toxicity, and neurotoxicity of the chemical substance or
19 mixture contained in the article. Exposing the public or
20 the environment to such article without generating such
21 studies shall be considered a prohibited act under this
22 Act.”.
